2. Signing Ceremony between MQA and ABEST21 International

On August 3rd 2023, ABEST21 International signed the MoU (Memorandum of Understanding) with Malaysian Qualification Agency (MQA) represented by CEO Dato' Professor Dr. Mohammad Shatar bin Sabran at Le Meridian Hotel, Putrajaya, Malaysia in the presence of Deputy Minister Dato' Haji Mohamad Yusof bin Apdal of Higher Education of Malaysia and First Secretary, Education and Science Attaché Mr. Yukiyoshi SAITO of Embassy of Japan in Malaysia, and Director General Professor Dr. Azlinda binti Azman of Department of Higher Education of Malaysia. ABEST21 International Vice President Professor Dr. Ali Khatibi, Senior Vice President, Management & Science University attended to the ceremony on behalf of our President and CEO Professor Emeritus Dr. Fumio ITOH. The main area of co-operation covered by the memorandum are a) exchange of operation information, b) exchange of information on status of accreditation, c) mutual understanding of approaches to enhance the understanding of quality assurance in higher education, d) quality system to ensure the role of both agencies, e) promotion of developmental opportunities for the staff of both agencies, f) engaging reviewers from both parties, g) collaborative accreditation programs, h) sharing Good Practice data base, etc. Some representative from ABEST21 International School members in Malaysia attended to the ceremony also. After then, Ms. Norasikin Binti Yahya introduced their training system for their applicant school and so on. At the end of this session, ABEST21 International Vice President Associate Professor Teguh Dartanto, Ph.D., Dean, Faculty of Economics and Business, Universitas Indonesia presented a commemorative item to these speakers.

3. New Deans

Dean Prof. Dr. Naziruddin Abdullah Universiti Kuala Lumpur Business School, Universiti Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

UniKL Business School was established in 2008 under the name of the University Kuala Lumpur School of Entrepreneurship or UniKL ISE. The new name was officially institutionalized in 2011. UniKL Business School has developed programs of study that are unique and focus on the needs of the industry and national development. The mission statement for all programs offered by the University Kuala Lumpur supports the larger mission of the university in relation to the community, society, and the environment. This is essential for the university to nurture all-encompassed graduates who are socially conscious and intellectually prepared to serve the nation.



In designing the syllabus and program structure, great care has been taken to ensure that the course contents are geared towards developing people with skills based on ethics and values that will empower the community, society, and the environment. To this end, most of the assignments given by the lecturers are in the form of group assignments where students are taught and inspired to work in a team, which will result in creating leadership, ethics, and communication skills.

Apart from that, students and staff are encouraged to join various CSR programs conducted by the Student Development and Campus Lifestyle (SDCL) Division. Some examples of the activities conducted were feeding the homeless, donation drives for orphans and children of the poor, help repair and renovate dilapidated houses for the poor etc. In addition, the UniKL Care is formed to promote university activity in community engagement. Emphasis is given on activities that have high impact elements; an example of which is helping out flood victims in north Malaysia as Malaysia is prone to monsoon season at the end of the year.

Equally important, the university also provides a platform for students to get themselves exposed to international learning environment through the International Exchange Program (ISEM). This will enable them to go to the designated foreign universities and learned not only academic's subjects but also foreign language, ethics, and cultures. The exchange program also provides us with the opportunity to host foreign students in our campuses, namely the QM City Campus and Gurney Campus. They, the foreign students, are able to mingle with the local students through group assignments and other academic and extra-curricular activities.

In order to facilitate students to learn, work, and engage in community service, the university offers several elective subjects of which Community Service is one of them. In these subjects, students are taught, among others, how to conduct social-related activities such as feeding the homeless, donation drives for orphans and children of the poor, and helping the single-parent.

With the above-mentioned initiatives and programs, UniKL provides a holistic and conducive environment for the local and international students to churn out their potential to the maximum, which in turn contributes to the nation building. Indeed, this, in one way or the other, serves the ultimate objective of the existence of UniKL and UniKL Business School, respectively.

4. New School Members

Banking and Finance Academy of Uzbekistan, Uzbekistan Acting Deputy Rector Dr. Sherzod Khannaev

Established in 1996 by a presidential decree, the Academy of Banking and Finance of the Republic of Uzbekistan has emerged as a distinguished institution in a relatively short span. With the unwavering support of the government, it has transformed into a modern hub for higher education and cutting-edge research.

Over the years, the Academy has nurtured more than 6,000 master's level students and over 12,000 students through its Faculty of Professional Development. Currently, it boasts a student body of 1,383 individuals, guided by a dedicated faculty of 47 members. The



institution's leadership is orchestrated by a Rector, supported by three deputy rectors overseeing Academic Affairs, Research and International Cooperation, as well as Financial and Economic Affairs. This is complemented by international exposure through internships in foreign countries. These initiatives have propelled the Academy to the forefront of the financial education landscape in Uzbekistan.

In addition to its master's programs, the Academy also offers bachelor's degree programs catering to students interested in the banking and finance sector. These programs include Bachelor of Banking and Auditing, Bachelor of Finance and Financial Technologies, Bachelor of Accounting and Auditing, and Bachelor of Economics. Typically spanning four years, these bachelor's programs are available in both full-time and part-time formats, with instruction in Uzbek and Russian.

Expanding its academic horizons, the Academy provides a diverse array of undergraduate and postgraduate programs. Master's degree offerings encompass Master of Business Administration (MBA) and Master of Science (MSc) programs across specialized fields such as Capital Market and Stock Exchange, Public Financial Control and Audit, Monetary Regulation of the Economy, Bank Accounting, Audit, and Control, Management of Insurance Companies, Pension Fund Management, Tax and Taxation, Project Management, and Islamic Finance and Banking. MBA programs generally span two years, while MSc programs require 14 months. Both full-time and part-time formats are available, with instruction offered in Uzbek and English.

In accordance with the Uzbek educational system, postgraduate studies are divided into two categories: Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) and Doctor of Science (DSc). These programs, available in part-time and full-time modes, span up to three years. Specializations include "Finance, Money Circulation, and Credit," "Accounting, Economic Analysis, and Audit," and "Digital Economy and

International Digital Integration."

Beyond traditional academic programs, the Academy plays a pivotal role in the retraining and skill development of managerial personnel within Uzbekistan's banking and financial institutions.

Dedicated to delivering high-quality education and professional development opportunities, the Academy is actively pursuing international recognition through accreditation from esteemed organizations like ABEST21, AACSB, and BGA. This commitment further underscores the institution's dedication to global educational standards and excellence.
